Dear Mr. Larson:

You appealed from the action of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) on your request for access to records pertaining to documentation of "errors" and "discrepancies" within the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record.

After carefully considering your appeal, I am affirming ATF's action on your request. ATF conducted a search for records responsive to your request and was unable to locate any records pertaining to the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record documentation you referred to in your request. I have determined that ATF's response was correct.

I note that ATF advised you in its response letter dated February 21, 2007 that it would conduct a supplemental search for the ATF form that you generally described in your January 24, 2007 request letter if you were able to provide more specific information to assist the ATF in identifying responsive records. I have been advised that you subsequently provided this information and that ATF opened a separate request (Request No. 07-808) to respond to that portion of your request. ATF's processing of this separate request was the subject of Appeal No. 07-1953.

If you are dissatisfied with my action on your appeal, you may seek judicial review in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B).
