Dear Sir,

On June 4, 2007, I mailed to your office ATF Form 4 Application for Tax Paid Transfer and Registration of Firearms along with the required supporting documents to transfer the here above referenced firearm. I have now received the here above referenced letter ([REDACTED]) indicating that proof of ownership for the subject firearm is required because the firearm is not shown registered to Pars International Corporation ("Pars"). The letter was accompanied by ATF Form 4 that have been stamped as [REDACTED]. Please take notice that the said firearm was delivered to Pars' premisses on April 30, 2007 and it was entered in the firearms Acquisition and Disposition records of Pars on the same date. The firearm was accompanied by an approved ATF Form-3 dated April 12, 2007, I have attached a copy of the form for your record.

Since it appears that the transfer to Pars was pursuant to an approved ATF Form3, I am very concerned that the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Records do not reflect the same. Therefore, I am requesting your written instruction as to steps need to be taken to resolve this issue. I am also returning the subject ATF Form 4 for any actions that need to be taken.
